RAIL TRAFFIC UNDERGROUND

By 1935 the United States will see on its streets and highways between 30,000,000 and 35,000,000 registered motor vehicles. How are we going to accommodate that great army of passenger cars, trucks and busses?

In the centers of our larger cities we are going to see most rail traffic underground. Some cities will have systems of subways. Other cities will route trolley cars underground in the centers of town.

The elevated structure idea for overhead trains will be abandoned in most cities. The elevated train was all right in its day possibly but today the subway in most cities must take its place because among other reasons the elevated structure adds to the congestion.

Many cities will find it necessary to remove trolley tracks in the centers of town and for surface cars use busses. There will always, no doubt, be a place for the trolley car in our country's transportation system but the bus as a more flexible means of transportation is going to supplant the surface car in the business centers of many cities. Then too busses will be used for the longer hauls.

The work of widening streets will ever continue. Where it can be done without difficulty streets will be made wider by narrowing parking areas and sidewalks as well.

Separation of grades is another step. New York, Detroit, San Francisco, Cincinnati — these are some of the cities that have built overpasses and have found them of genuine help in expediting the movement of traffic.

WAREHOUSE IN ST. LOUIS FOR THE J. C. PENNEY COMPANY

Plans for the establishment in St. Louis of a general distribution center for the J. C. Penney Company, nationwide organization of department stores, was announced this week by Mr. Glen G. White, director in charge of the real estate department.

The total investment of the J. C. Penney Company in the St. Louis warehouse will be approximately \$2,500,000, including both land and building.

The building will be 12 stories high and will have a floor space of 792,000 square feet. Construction will begin early in March.

This is the second warehouse established by the company in the last two years. The New York warehouse, costing \$3,750,000, was completed in January, 1926.

Distribution through the St. Louis warehouse will mean a saving of from two to ten days in transit time for shipments to western stores.

Aitken of Tombstone, grand high priest of the Royal Arch Masons, Deputy Grand Master Morris Goldwater of Bisbee, grand master of the Royal and Select Masters, and Louis G. Moyers of Globe, president of the Past Grand Masters' Association.
